We are excited to share some important news about the future of Headway Bristol. After careful consideration and extensive discussions, we have decided to relocate our premises in September. This decision was made to ensure the long-term sustainability and growth of our charity.

A Look Back:

Over the past nine years, we have been based at the Frenchay Beckspool Building. Initially, we moved from Headway House on the Frenchay site to this building, negotiating leases with its various owners, most recently the North Bristol Trust. However, it has become clear that remaining in our current location is not financially viable for the long term.

Our time at Frenchay has been wonderful, however things have changed dramatically since the Frenchay site changed from what was once a hospital to what it is today.

The costs associated with leasing and maintaining the Frenchay Beckspool Building have increased, and we must prioritise the long-term financial health of our charity to continue providing essential services. Moreover, the evolving needs of our service users require a more adaptable and resource-rich environment, which our current location can no longer adequately provide.







A Bright Future:

We are thrilled to announce our move to two new locations that will greatly benefit our charity and the communities we serve:

- 1. **The Brightwell Centre in Bradley Stoke**: A centre for neurological wellbeing and physical recovery. This space will allow us to collaborate with other organisations and offer enhanced services to our service users and their families.
- 2. **The Wellspring Settlement in Barton Hill**: This location presents an incredible opportunity for us to integrate into a vibrant community. The Wellspring Settlement offers an abundance of opportunities and various facilities, including an art studio, yoga studio, dance rooms, and fully equipped kitchens. This will enable us to expand our programs and raise awareness of Headway Bristol within the community.

We will also continue to operate our hubs at the Greenway Centre and the Withywood Centre, ensuring continuity and familiarity for our service users.

Looking Ahead:

Our charity has long operated on a hub model, and we are eager to hear from you about how you envision our new spaces. Your feedback is invaluable as we design our new hubs to meet your needs and make you feel at home.

Over the coming months we want to hear directly from those who currently access our service around how you want our new hub model to look. What do you want to see inside our new spaces? How do you want it to make you feel? We look forward to spending some time with you over the coming months around this exciting project.

The charity has worked on a hub model for some years now, with spaces already operating at the Greenway Centre and the Withywood centre, this will see us continue to have licence of space to make me these new hubs our own unique space that only we can access.
